Dear Henninger Black Knights,

We are so close and we are prepared and ready for you! We will begin our in-person, one day per week, Hybrid model of instruction on October 5, 2020. Each day will begin at 8:45 am and end at 12:45 pm. Hybrid students will attend one day as follows:

· Monday: Pod 1 (9/10)

· Tuesday: Pod 2 (9/10)

· Wednesday: Asynchronous learning/virtual, students will do Canvas work from home

· Thursday: Pod 3 (11/12)

· Friday: Pod 4 (11/12)

Pod 5 ENL: Entering and Emerging M, T, Th, F Special Education: 15:1 and 12:1:1 M, T, Th, F

Pod 6 – Virtual Students

If you aren't sure what pod you are in please go to schooltool, put your cursor over the burgundy flag, under your photo, it will tell you what pod you are in and what day you will attend.

On the day your child is in school, he/she will have in-person teacher instruction. On Wednesdays your child will be working asynchronously, utilizing canvas or other work assigned by their teachers. On the remaining 3 days, your child will be working virtually with their teacher.

**Example:** Monday - school, Tuesday-virtual, Wednesday-asynchronous, Thursday-virtual, and Friday-virtual (This is just a sample of what a 9/10 student's weekly schedule may look like.)

When students come to school on their scheduled day, they will enter the school as follows:

- · All walkers and students that are dropped off will enter through, single point, the front doors.
- · All Centro bus students will enter through the bus doors

All students that ride the yellow bus will enter through the cafeteria doors.

If your child is an entering or emerging ENL student, or a student in our Special Ed program they will attend school, Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday, from 8:45am-12:45pm. ENL, 15:1 and 12:1:1students will enter the building through the cafeteria entrance where it is wheelchair

accessible.

For Parents whose children qualify for busing (students who live 1.5 miles or more from Henninger):

Parent should call **Centro** on **315-442-3400** and provide student name and school name in order to obtain information about bus stop and time to be at stop for bus pick up to school in the morning. District Transportation cannot provide this information to parents.

## For Students with IEP whose IEP specify special transportation:

The District Analyst sets up the busing for the student and notifies the parents and the school in writing, by mailed letter.

District Transportation number is (315) 435-4260.

Staff will be outside to assist all students with the new entrances. Temperature takers will also be available at each of these entry points.

Students are to remember that they will have to adhere to the school/CDC guidelines and wear a mask. If they should forget, their mask one will be provided. Hand sanitizer will be available in every classroom and found in the hallways from dispensers.

Breakfast and lunch will be provided for your child, when they attend.

Please have your child check their schedule for any updates and to know the classroom number they will go to for their first period, the day before they come to school.
