



People grow and change. Story **characters** change, too. People's experiences and relationships can both cause the changes.




Beginning Map and Talk <u>Middle</u>

Middle




The pirates attack the fort, steal the map, and capture Jim. When they dig up the treasure, there are only two gold coins!
