





Grammar Rules Regular Past Tense

Add -ed to many action verbs to show that action happened in the past.

$$verb + -ed = past tense$$



In the past, people copied each book by hand. Now books are printed on machines. You can read books on computers, too.




In the past, people sent messages with telegraph machines. Now people call each other on telephones. People also wrote letters in the past. Now people send e-mail messages on computers.




In the past, people bought newspapers to read. Now people have newspapers delivered. They also read them on the internet. Communication will continue to change. What will happen next?



## **Past Tense Verbs**

**Verbs** can tell about actions that happened in the past.



Grammar Rules Past Tense Verbs	
To make a verb about the past:  • Add - <u>ed</u> to the end of a regular verb, like want.	Today people <b>want</b> to build new spaceships. In the past, they <b>wanted</b> to build the first spaceship.
<ul> <li>Use a special form for an irregular verb, like fly.</li> </ul>	Today people <b>fly</b> to space. In the past, they <b>flew</b> to space for the first time.


