With the varsity and junior varsity sports seasons about to get underway I want to share some very important information with you regarding your child's participation in athletics at Nottingham HS. Depending on the sport, your child may practice at an offsite location (see below for sites of sports). Transportation will be provided.

All athletes must have an updated physical within one year. All parents must use FamilyID to sign students up for sports. Family ID will be open for registration on July 23, 2023. Directions are below to sign-up through FamilyID:

- Go to familyid.com, then click on Get Started Now button.
- Fill out form and click create account (write password down somewhere).
- Activate account by checking your email. Click on the email from FamilyID. then click email link to FamilyID,
- Type Syracuse City School District in the search box, then click find. Click on Nottingham High School Fall 2023, click Register now
- Scroll down until you see the team your student wants to participate with click on team, scroll down, and fill out form (answer all questions)

We ask that parents attend a parent meeting to meet their child's coach and go over the rules and expectations of the program. The parent meeting will be August 30, 2023, at Nottingham. At the meeting, parents will be asked to sign the program expectation sheet.

	Student continues to participate.			
	 Progress is monitored weekly in classes through progress reports. 			
	Student has 2 weeks to improve and reach a passing grade after which the student would move to monitoring until the next marking period.			
Failing 2 courses	10 th – 12 th graders – Limited Participation/9 th graders – Monitoring (see above)			
	 Student may continue to participate, but may not compete, perform, or represent for their activity/organization. 			
	 Progress is monitored weekly in all classes through progress reports. 			
	Student has 2 weeks to improve at least one course to passing after which the student would move to probation for additional 2 weeks.			
Failing 3 or more	10 th – 12 th graders – Ineligible/9 th graders – Limited Participation (see above)			
courses	 Student may not participate until grades are re-assessed in the next report card. 			
	• If their grades have not improved, or if there is not a report card before the next season or event, they will be ineligible for the next season as well.

Students will begin with eligibility and credits will be monitored	First Year
Prior to the start of school year student will have earned 4 credits includes (physical education) to participate	Second Year
Prior to the start of school year student will have earned 9 credits includes (physical education) to participate	Third Year
Prior to the start of school year student will have earned 14 credits includes (physical education) to participate	Fourth Year
