Minutes from Meeting:

Ms. Formica reported that ITC hosted some important visitors to the building today (10/17/18); NYS Commissioner of Labor, Ms. Roberta Reardon and Superintendent of Syracuse City Schools, Mr. Jaime Alicea toured the building and individual CTE classrooms to see how the pathways are working with hands on learning for our students. [From the web: *The New York State Department of Labor Commissioner Roberta Reardon oversees the Department's more than 3,300 employees. The position is nominated by the Governor and approved by a vote in the NYS Senate.*]

With so much violence outside of school, administrators want parents to be assured that ITC's leadership is working with all faculty and community leaders to build a safe community inside the school. Ways in place to help students, Officer Black and other support staff are available and very visible throughout the school day. If you have any suggestions, please let Ms. Formica or Mr. Natoli know. Both will look for any best practices. Someone at meeting recommended the Boys & Girls Clubs [4 Syracuse locations visit - http://www.bgcsyracuse.org/ or phone:315-472-4767] and the Southwest Community Center [401 South Ave; Syracuse, NY phone 315-474-6823] as activity centers for students after school and on weekends.

After-school tutoring has started. The tutoring hours are offered by our faculty in various departments, the schedule is posted on ITC website. Paper copies available by calling the school office; 315-435-4300. Students should go to classroom listed on schedule. Also, the school Library / Media Center stays open until 4:00 pm for any students who want homework space and/or help.

Mr. Sohoski demonstrated how parents can make good use of the website and school calendar. Be sure to filter by school for ITC's calendar. Also on website are important links and tutoring schedule. Many announcements on home page.

Some important links on PFO page: COLLEGE BOARD: Create an account early and visit often as your student develops their high school profile.

ITC uses CLEVER. Each students gets a log-in for their general academic use. They can access Castle Learning (curriculum lessons), Mackinvia (audio books & e-books), and other apps that can be used as study guides and study aids. Specifically, for Regents studies, you can access related vocabulary, data reports and flash cards based on the curriculum your student is studying.

When you are at CLEVER – every icon page will vary by student. Also linked to the NYC Library – see Mr. Sohoski so he can assist you in getting a library card to access all they have at NYC Metropolitan Library.

Also, you can use E-School to check your student's attendance, schedule by day, grades, class work due dates, and to email teachers. You can also see and print transcripts, report cards, and regents test scores. [By the way, if your student is late and swipes his ID card in the system, the monetary fine that registers is not real.]
