

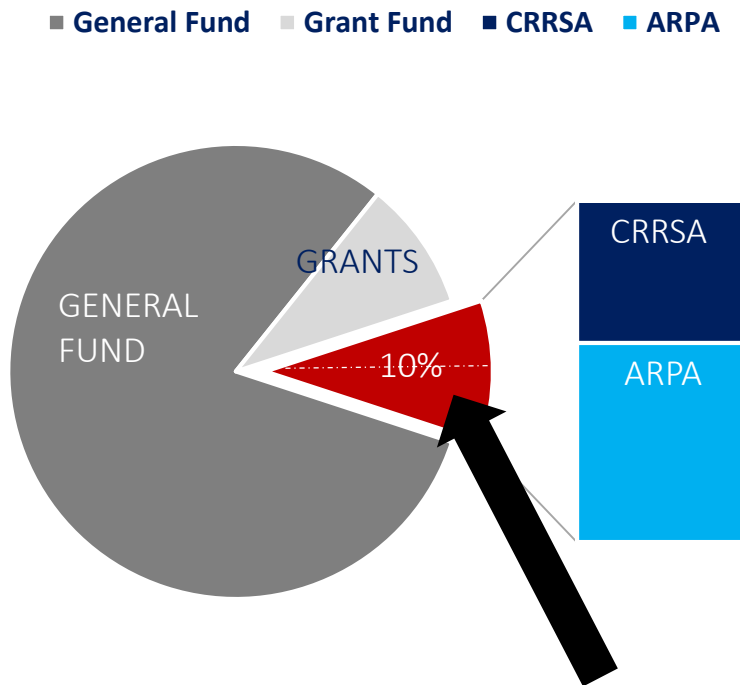

Federal Stimulus Funds



- ARPA & CRRSA Federal Stimulus funds will be about 10% of all the money the district spends this school year
- ARPA alone will be about 6%
- The ARPA plan and the ARPA survey apply only to this 6%
- Stipulations on what ARPA funds can be spent on

Minimum 20% to address Loss Instructional Time with evidence-based interventions such as:

- Summer Learning & Enrichment
- Extended Day & Afterschool
- Extended School Year

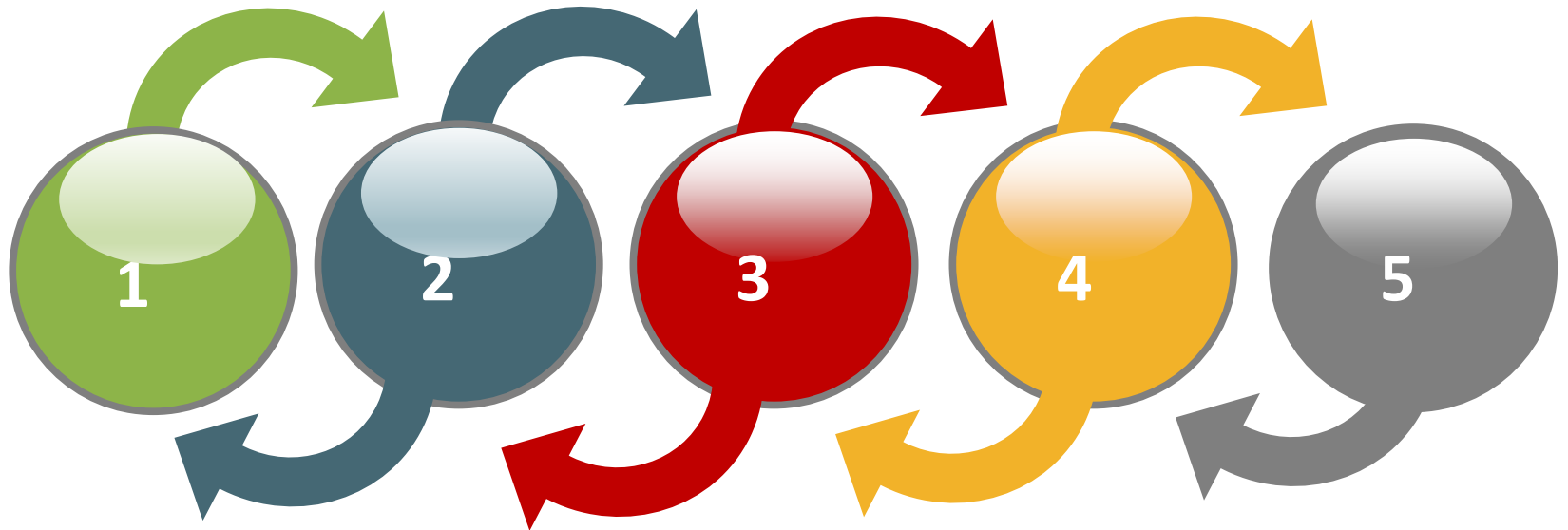
Ensuring interventions respond to academic and social emotional needs

- High quality academic assessments
- Tracking attendance
- Building repairs and upgrades addressing indoor air quality and mechanicals
- Safe return to in-person learning
- Strategies to implement public health protocols

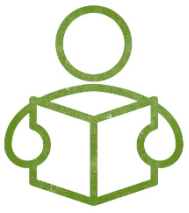
- Coordination with other entities to slow spread of COVID-19
- Improve preparedness for a pandemic
- Training to minimize spread of disease
- Supplies & equipment to sanitize
- Plan for long-term school closures including delivery of meals & technology
- Technology and connectivity
- Mental Health supports and full-service community schools
- Parent and Family assistance to effectively support students
- Maintenance of Equity Requirement

ARPA-ESSER Funding requires public comment from parents, teachers and stakeholders and funding requires creation and publication of spending plan

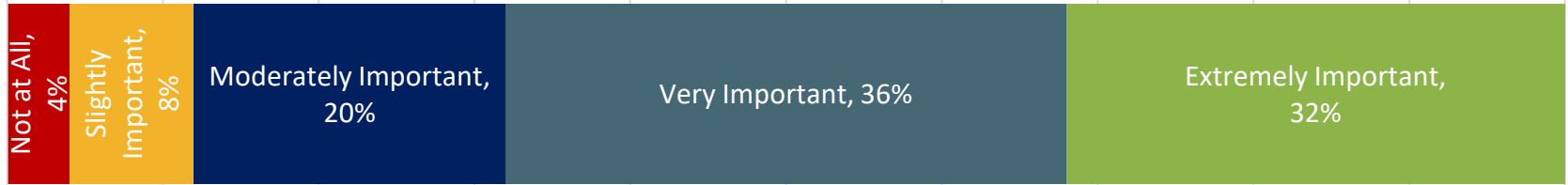

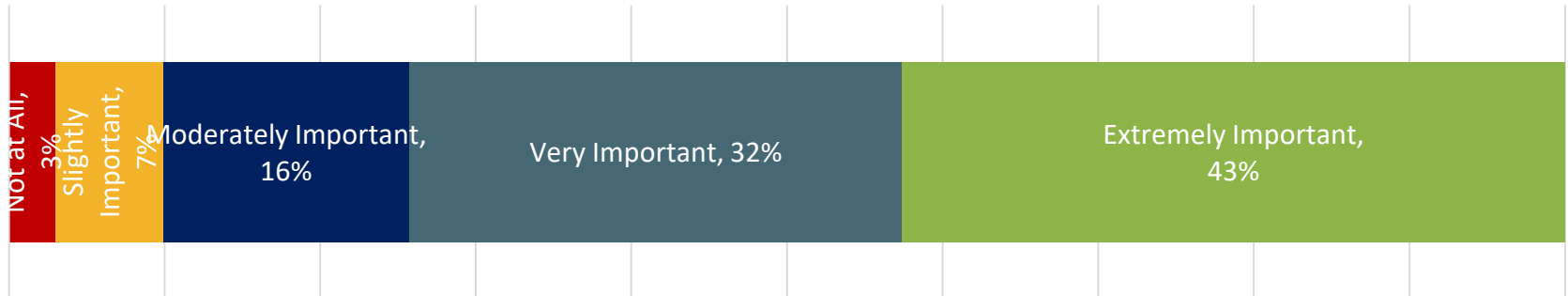
LEARNING - ACCELERATION OF INSTRUCTION



- Full-Day Summer Enrichment (morning academics and afternoon activities)
- Reading & Math Intensive Support
- Additional Supports for Students with Disabilities
- Specific English Language Learner focus
- Field Trips / Civic Engagement
- Virtual High School Academy



MENTAL HEALTH & SOCIAL-EMOTIONAL WELL-BEING



- Culturally appropriate books & materials supporting mental health and social-emotional well-being
- Partner with community agencies
- Additional access to Psychologists, Social Workers and Counselors
- Attendance Teams focused on getting kids back to school



AIR QUALITY



- Air Purifiers / Air Filters
- Upgrade Ventilation Systems
- Update Heating Ventilation & Air Conditioning (HVAC) Controls
- Replace Windows
- Replace Carpet and Flooring



TECHNOLOGY



- Provide a new laptop to every high school student starting with 9th grade students
- WIFI connectivity and laptops on hand for remote learning

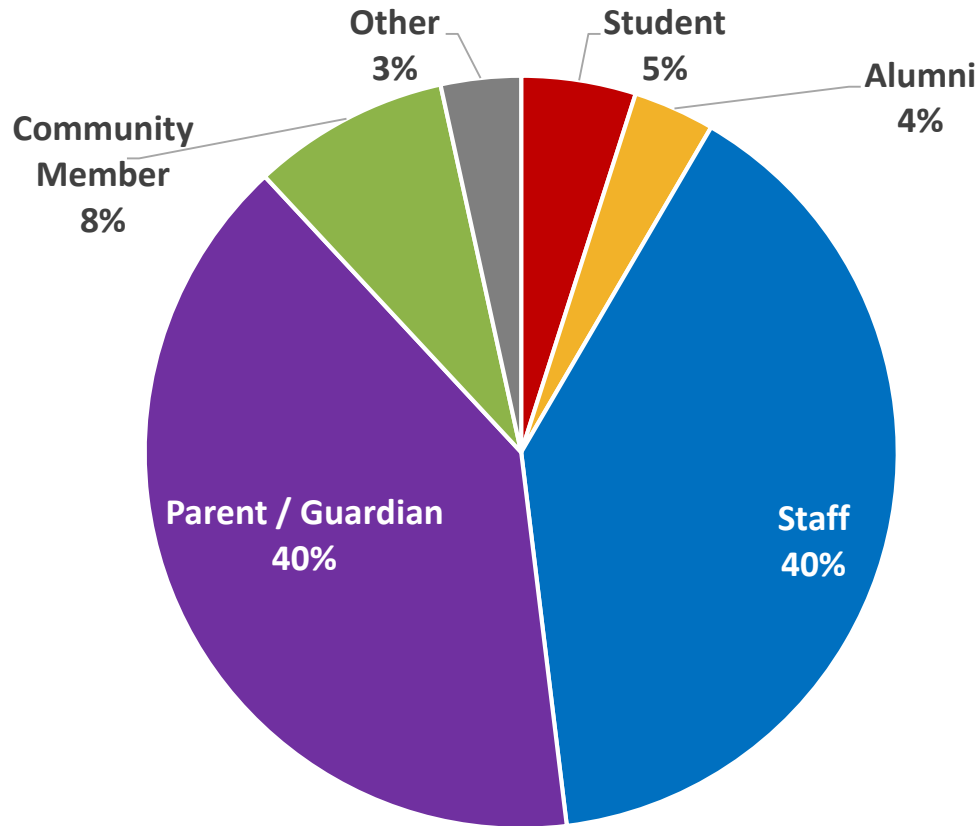

Who Responded



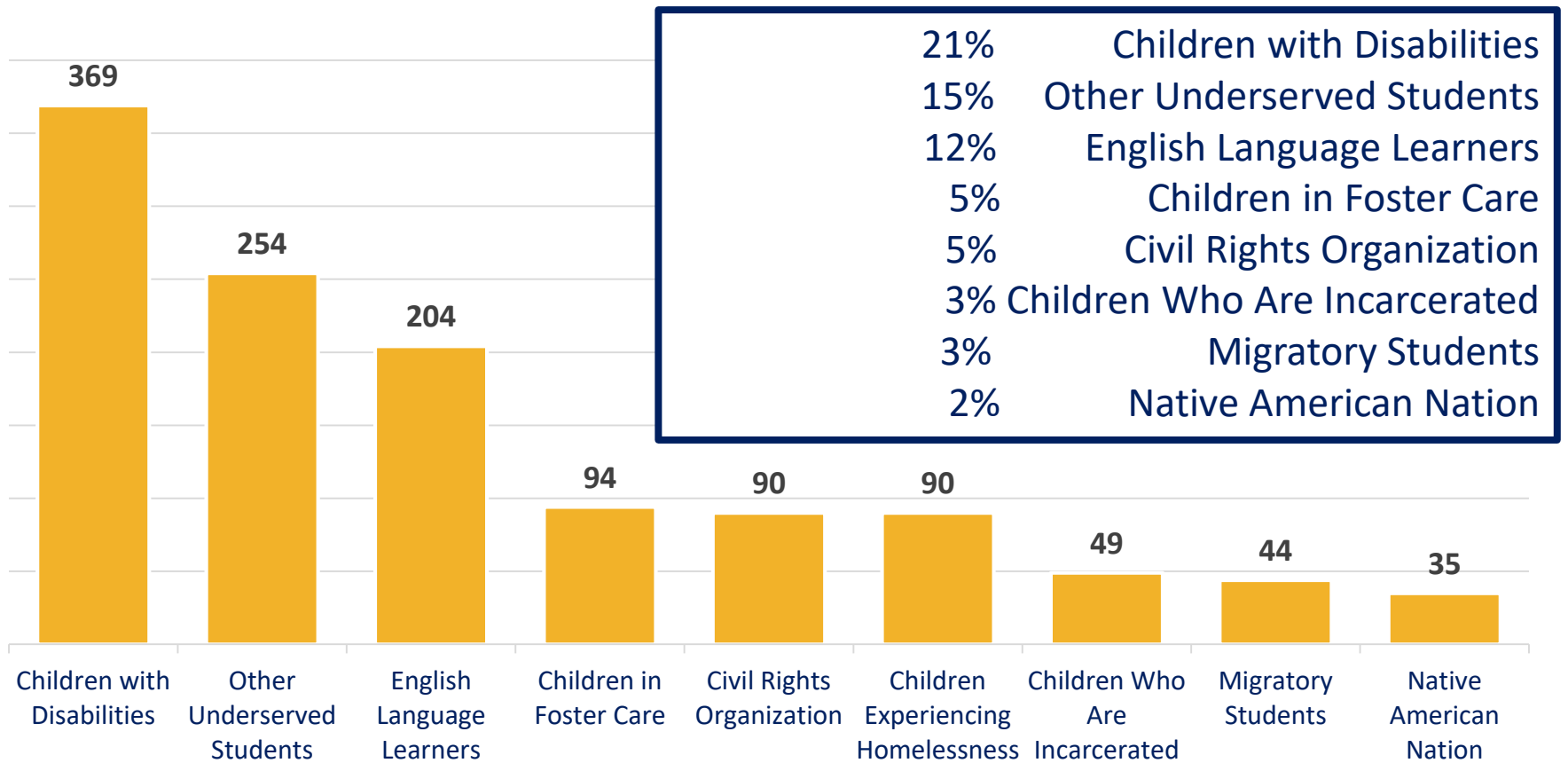
2,252 Surveys were opened

1,721 Surveys were submitted and responded to some or all of the questions

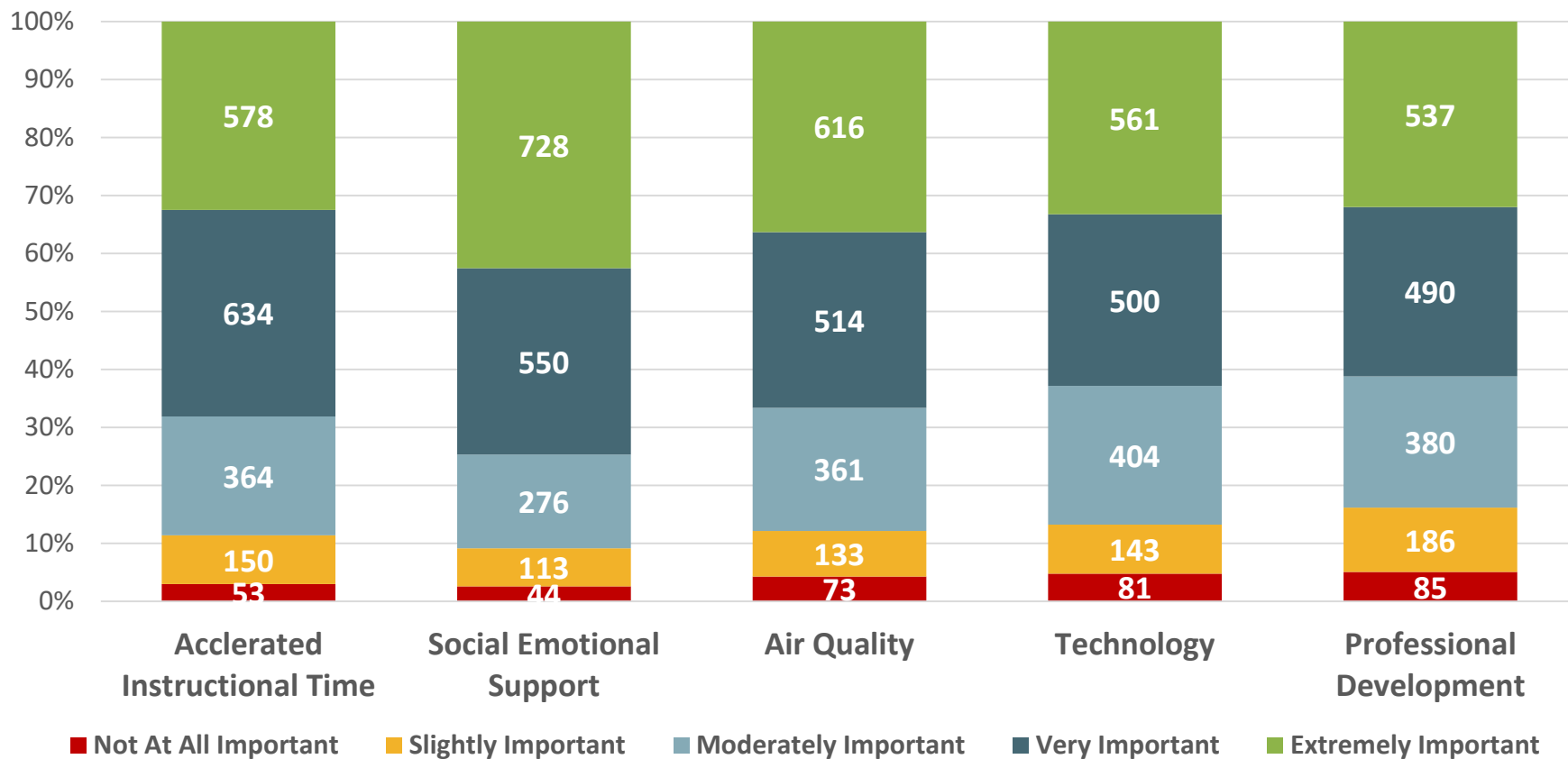

Comments & Feedback

- More staff – Teachers, TA's & reduce class size
- Tutors before and afterschool and in evening
- Bring back Foster Grandparents
- Assimilate new online streaming culture to engage kids – create SCSD Portal to encourage students learn at their own pace
- Partner with ethnic-based community organizations



Comments & Feedback

- Consistent curriculum / universal design for learning
- Student-friendly materials and systems
- Re-establish clubs and committee activities
- Adaptive equipment for special needs (speech, hearing)
- Peer mentors & community role model mentors
- Relationship building that help students and families feel connected to school
- Bring back the middle school GREAT program



Comments & Feedback

- Robust college & career readiness centers in high schools
- More supply money for classroom teachers
- Re-establish health classes led by certified health instructors and mental health professionals
- Open school libraries all summer
- Create outdoor learning labs
- Provide investigative & exploratory activities



Comments & Feedback

- Increase transportation
- High expectations for behavior
- Designated recess time
- Sports offerings at all grade levels
- Turf baseball fields
- Bridge programs for transitioning to middle and high school with skill development for note-taking & time management
- Social skill development for early grades



Comments & Feedback

- Teach Life Skills – taxes, insurance, banking, buying a car, buying a house and parenting
- HBCU College Tour
- More therapists – speech, occupational therapists, physical therapists, hearing impaired
- Teach fun stuff – fishing, kayaking, camping, skiing, photography, gardening, knitting



Comments & Feedback

- Air Conditioning / cover skylights / fans
- Building renovations and updates
- Air quality, filtration and circulation
- Cleanliness of buildings
- 1:1 devices at all grades
 - 50 / 50 split - if students should be allowed to take devices home
- Citywide broadband access
- Suggestions for different brands & types of technology devices and broadband / Wi-Fi



Comments & Feedback

- Test and upgrade water systems
- Update bathroom facilities with more sinks
- Improve classroom furniture
- DARE Program – Drug Abuse Resistance Education
- LGBTQ Education
- Address gangs and violence in the streets
- Start school 2 weeks earlier instead of summer school

- Bi-Lingual development for teachers
- 50 / 50 split on support for Professional Development

- 12-month enrichment programming

ARPA Next Steps



- Still waiting for State guidance and ARPA application ...
- Incorporate feedback into ARPA Plan and communicate 'feedback action plan'
- Request Board approval on ARPA Plan
- Post & Submit ARPA Plan
- Implement and continuously review federal stimulus investments and spending plan
- Ensure systems and processes align to audit standards
